We pray this letter finds you all well and being faithful to our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Though it has been a few months since our last letter, God has shown us that faithfulness in Him comes with an unsurpassable amount of blessings. Even through this "Great Pandemic" I can still boldly stand and say God is Good. Recently we have been accepted by All Points Baptist Missions and now have a mission agency. What a blessing! We have also had many cancelled meetings, but have been able to still communicate with some churches to keep a couple of our meetings. I struggled over the last several months to schedule meetings for this time of year, and now I know why: God is moving us to our field in June!

Yes you read right! We will be departing Pilot Mountain, NC, Lord-willing, on June 15th headed for Alaska. With a great amount of prayer and searching God's Word for His will, He has shown us that it is time to go! The plan is to work in the field and to continue deputation also, as we are there. Please pray for us as we make preparations.

We are looking at expenses for moving, and though overwhelming as they may sound, God will supply. To have our belongings one of our vehicles moved will cost in the neighborhood of \$5,000, which will be much more economical than selling all and replacing it. Also, part of the plan is that we are going to drive and take the opportunity to set appointments with a few missionaries along the way. We hope to spend some time with them, and prayerfully, to be a blessing to them in any way that God wants us to be. Relocating is a financial mountain and we are only at about ten percent of our support, and it seems as though every time we have our goal amount saved, God allows some financial burden to come along and deplete our savings. Rather than see this as an obstacle to defeat our goal, we see it as an opportunity for God's glory to show forth. He has said to go and He will provide. Please, pray for God to fully supply this financial need and to supply traveling grace!

We have one more meeting in Georgia before we leave out and we ask that you pray for that. I know as a Christian we struggle everyday with many obstacles in our lives, and I'm reminded of what Paul told the men on the ship as they sailed, against Paul's warning, to bring him before Caesar. Through all the rages of the storm, God told Paul, "**Fear not**", and that He had given all them that are before him, which were to be told the Gospel. And as Paul told them this he said, "Wherefore sirs be of good cheer: for **I believe God**, that it shall be even as it was told me." Acts 27:25

When God speaks, do we believe and go on for Him? I would like to believe that I do! We all have an appointment. Let God guide you and ask yourself honestly, "Do I believe God?"
