In just the last few months, God has sent more applicants and inquiries to APBM for the U.S. Military Chaplaincy than at any time I can remember. Not all of these applicants work out for this ministry of course. Some have doctrinal issues that do not line up with APBM (Dir.: Dr. Robbie Morrison) which is a ministry of the Calvary Baptist Church in New Philadelphia, OH (Pastor: Dr. Don Snow). Some applicants have medical disqualifiers that eliminate them from military service. In every case, we spend much time interviewing and working with the applicant and his Pastor. What's exciting about the process is that many Pastors are not fully aware of the freedom Chaplains have to evangelize in the military nor of all of the D.O.D. (Dept. of Defense) requirements to be a military chaplain. This provides us a great opportunity to share our ministry with new Pastors and Churches.

As stated, God has given great increase in these past months for future candidates that will, by God's grace, be endorsed by APBM to be U.S. Military Chaplains. For what purpose? *"..that the abundant grace might through the thanksgiving of many redound to the glory of God."* The many souls in our military that have been born again by the power of the gospel of Jesus Christ are the "thanksgiving of many". Imagine the soul of a soldier who by faith knows the peace of sins forgiven, the power of the resurrection through Christ, and the personal comfort of the indwelling of the Holy Spirit! The thankfulness of that soul saved results in God getting the glory. That's what this ministry is all about. May the Lord Jesus Christ continue to have the preeminence, and all the glory for the many of our brave men and women in uniform that come to know Him as Savior.
