Dear Pastor and Church:

Greetings in the wonderful name of our Jesus, our Saviour. I trust this New Year has been a blessing for all of you. Thank God He has given us another opportunity to serve and love Him.

These past three months have been a time of healing. Carolyn has recovered from covid-19 with a slight problem with her eyes. But it is improving. I still have side effects of shortness of breath and coughing and asthma. But I am getting better. Thank you for your prayers.

We have had a great winter. Less than a foot of snow, and just three weeks of sub-zero temperatures where it didn't get above zero. That is nothing like we have seen in the past. One can pretty well handle this.

Things in Devils Lake are opening back up. We are around 80% normal. But Spirit Lake Reservation is still closed. We haven't been able to have services there yet. Some of the Native Americans have been driving into town for our Sunday services.

I have been visiting a man on the reservation, his name is Dennis Keo. I have known him for 17 years. He is big in the Indian religion. He has been to some of our services on the reservation. I have witnessed to him many times. Dennis had a stroke and Covid-19 at the same time. This handicapped him. Through this I have been able to once again witness to him; and I prayed with him. He told me he received Jesus as his Saviour. Pray for him and his family.

Our plan is, that when we get the new Church building built here in town is to bus people in from the reservation for services until they open the reservation up. Please make this a matter of prayer. Also please pray for a family on the reservation; the mother is trying to get her son and grandson to go to treatment for drug and alcohol addiction at Pacific Garden Mission in Chicago. Pray for the unsaved here in Devils Lake and on the Reservation. Please pray for our three Sons. Thank You for your prayer and financial Support.

Dear Pastor,

I hope everything is going well in your ministry. There is nothing like serving God by ministering the Gospel of Jesus to the need of people. Especially when it comes to one's Salvation. Or a Brother or sister in Christ who just needs someone to pray with them; or give them encouragement.

I want to Thank You All for your prayers and financial support through all these years; So I could do what the Lord has called me to do. Working with the Indians on Spirit Lake Sioux Reservation; and the white people here in Devils Lake. You all will be rewarded for the fruits of our labor.

Pastor; I have a special Prayer request and a need. As I have mentioned many times in our newsletters, we have 20 acres of land here in Devils Lake, ND. paid for, and \$57,000.00 in the Bank. We want to put a Church building on this property. Our plans are to put up a metal building 50 X 100. We are now having our services in a two room rented building. We are going to do it in 3 phases.

Phase One:

Put in a sewer system, dig and pour the foundation. We have enough money to get this done. But we need \$5,000.00 more to pay 10% down on the building so the contractor will have the specs to dig the foundation. We have already talked to a contractor about this.

Phase Two.

We have Friends who have put these buildings up many times; and they have agreed to help us out. The cost of this will be around \$20,000.00.

Phase Three.

Is finishing the inside of the building. Once again we have experienced people that will do this for us. We will be doing this little by little. The Sanctuary and restrooms first and then the remainder as the Lord provides.

Pastor please help us pray for this. There are less than 20 Independent Fundamental Baptist Churches in the state of North Dakota. There are Catholic and Lutheran who base their salvation on works and Baby Baptism, and rituals. Charismatic's who base everything on feelings and emotions. And Indian religion who worships creation not the Creator, the same as the new age movement.

Pastor, our desire is that when this Church is built and as it grows we can start a drug and alcoholic rehabilitation center and one day a Christian boarding school. Please help us pray for wisdom and direction and God's Perfect will be done.

I know Churches all across our nation are suffering because of this Covid-19. But my God is bigger than covid. If the Lord lays it on your heart to give to this, we would greatly appreciate it.
