Dear Church and Praying Friends,

1 Peter 1:8 Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory:

My heart is erupting over the goodness of God. The Lord continues to move here in this church plant. Folks in the church are excited and getting involved in every aspect of the ministry. When spring came we set a goal of knocking on every door in our community (4400) and I am thrilled to say we have accomplished that and have started over again knocking around 500 again already. There have been over 1000 tracts given out in our everyday lives. We are just finishing up a Soul Winner's class, which has been well attended by people in the church. Through the outreach, we have seen many visitors. Since March there have been 122 first time visitors, which is absolutely amazing to me. We have seen a total of 12 professions of faith and 11 baptisms so far. There are 17 of those visitors now coming regularly (most services if not all); 35 of those who have come to multiple services at different times. The Lord truly has been good to us. Our big day so far has been 58, Praise the Lord!

On the individual side of the ministry, there have been several people called into various aspects. An older couple has surrendered to work with the youth. This couple was saved back in November and the Lord has done a mighty work in their lives, as far as a complete change in their life. They have truly been a blessing. We have had many decisions made over the last few months. A young man (19) has surrendered to preach, a young lady to the mission field and another to do whatever the Lord wants her to do. The Lord is truly working here in the lives of people.

On the home front, our house sold in Bathurst and we are currently trying to get a house here. Be in much prayer concerning this. I had mentioned the last time that I twisted my ankle. As it turns out, I tore ligaments on both sides of my ankle and I am currently awaiting surgery to repair it. The last few weeks I have had to become the cheerleader for the door knocking effort as I was advised by my doctor to not do any more damage to it. Sarah is also awaiting surgery for a non-cancerous fibroid tumor. It is scheduled for October 26th. Elisabeth is going to have her knee ligaments repaired from where she dislocated her kneecap I spoke of in the last letter.
